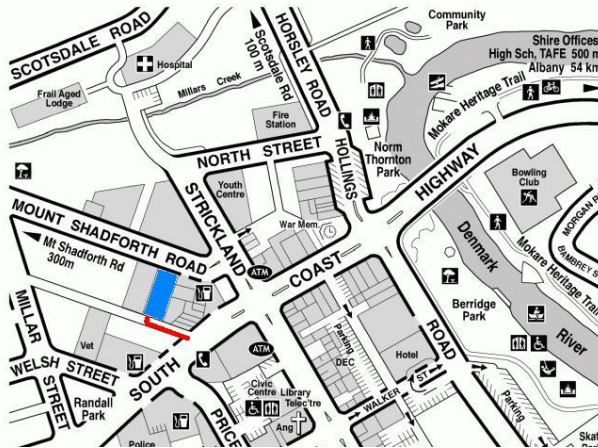
Sharon enjoys surfing, swimming and taking her kids to surf lifesaving club and soccer.
